- Explore links between education, the labor market, and applied learning.
- Learn from higher education and school education experiences.
- Build a practical vision adaptable to Arab contexts.

- Researchers and professionals interested in education policy and capacity building.

Toronto

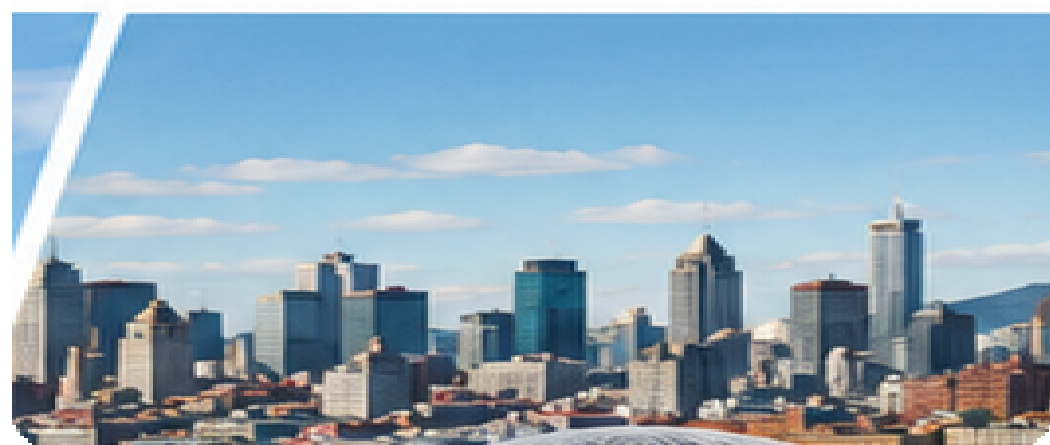
Attendance at CICE-2026 and proposed visits to Toronto Metropolitan University, University of Toronto, and York University, with a Generation1.ca session.

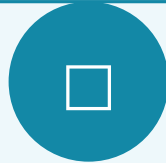

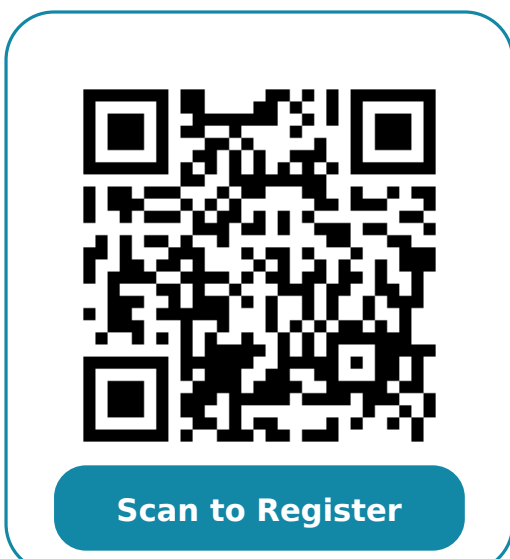
